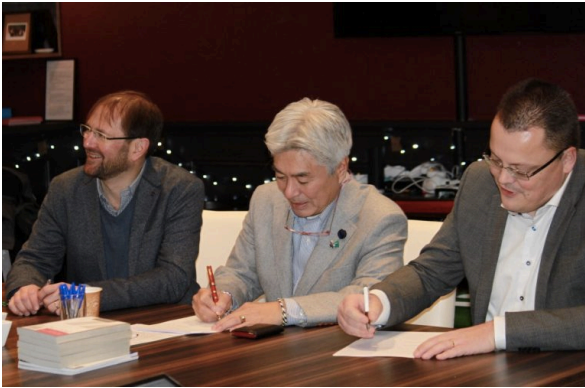
INDICA
